MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Kennecott Land

And

Residential Energy Services Network, Inc.

1.0 Purpose

Kennecott Land and the Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET) enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in order to promote the construction of energy efficient homes.

2.0 Goal of Agreement

The goal of this Memorandum of Understanding is to show consumers the value of a new home verses existing homes and, by labeling homes with a Home Energy Rating System Index (HERS).

It is the current intent of Kennecott Land, under this agreement, to market the HERS Index on all homes in new projects.

The intent of this agreement is to raise consumers' knowledge of new home performance using the HERS Index.

It is expected that this agreement will serve as a model for production Builders, and will result in positive outcomes for consumers, RESNET and the new home industry.

3.0 Terms and Conditions of the MOU

The intent of this agreement is that Kennecott Land will provide an energy label for each new home built in Daybreak. The energy label will contain the RESNET HERS Index. Kennecott Land's current HERS marketing scheme is attached in Attachment A.

- 3.1 All new homes constructed in Daybreak will be tested and inspected by a RESNET rater following RESNET's standards, and provided with a HERS Index produced by a RESNET accredited rating software program.
- 4.0 Administration of the Agreement


- 4.1 Each *organization* agrees to identify a contact person(s) to monitor and assess implementation and application of the agreement within their *organization* and to address inquiries, disputes or questions arising from the implementation of the agreement.
- 4.2 Each *organization* agrees that this agreement is a dynamic and evolving instrument that may be amended with the consent of both *organizations*. The *organizations* agree to initiate periodic reviews of this agreement every year after 2011, and the operation of the agreement when such request is made by one of the organizations.
- 4.3 This memorandum of understanding shall be for an initial term expiring December 31, 2011. Thereafter this memorandum of understanding shall renew annually. Either **organization** may terminate this memorandum of understanding by giving the other party at least sixty (60) days prior written notice of such termination. Termination may be without cause and the neither party shall have any liability to the other as a result of such termination.
